The International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI) needs your expertise to develop efficient and application-orientated emission reduction strategies. ILRI is part of the CGIAR network of international research institutes, which receives support from the German Government and other international donors for development-orientated agricultural research. Research at ILRI focuses on the breeding, health and nutrition of animals. To further explore the ecological footprint of agricultural production systems – mainly livestock systems – ILRI has established the Mazingira Center as a new research area. Its main focus is on the relationship between animal nutrition and greenhouse gas emissions.

Your tasks will involve:

- Conduct measurements on agronomy, livestock productivity and greenhouse gas emissions of different livestock systems
- Developing recommendations for resource-efficient livestock systems in Sub-Saharan Africa
- Manage and maintain laboratory and field facilities, especially in respiration chambers, in order to measure the climate-damaging emissions of ruminant animals
