
Event title: Forum on "Promoting gender equality for sustainable forestry development"

Venue and time: Binh Dinh province, 5-6 October 2023

Background: Gender equality in the forestry sector remains an important topic. Addressing inequalities in labour division, remuneration, employment opportunities, and forest land allocation is crucial for both the country in general and sustainable development specifically. In this context, the forum on "Promoting Gender Equality for Sustainable Forestry Development" was co-organised by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD) — represented by the Department of Forestry (DOF) and the Management Board of Forestry Projects (MBFP), the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH in cooperation with other partners. Under the motto "Gender Equality for Sustainable Forestry," this 1.5-day event has provided new insights and inspiration on gender equality in the forestry sector. 162 participants had the opportunity to connect and forge alliances with like-minded peers in the sector. Having been reinforced by the event, the joint work to increase efforts towards ensuring that women and men receive equal benefits from forests and timber processing will continue.


Monitoring methodology: This report provides a media clip monitoring of publications about the above-mentioned event. The monitoring scope is nationwide in the time frame from 05 to 10 October 2023. Media publication media include news article, website articles (governmental and provincial portals), social media posts of GIZ and the German Embassy, TV broadcasted news, as well as publications by other organisations and associations reporting about the event. Printed media was not monitored and is hence not included in this report.

Results: In summary, 34 media publications have been recorded during 5-10 October. The majority of publications appeared in the online newspaper, while social media and other websites also played an important role (see figure below). Informative content articles on the roles of women and overall gender equality towards a sustainable forestry, etc. have been noted. This coverage can be assessed as an comparatively high with an impressive impact. Consequently, a certain number of forestry companies, organisations, authorities, and public in Viet Nam are now more aware about these issues.



Most of the media mentioned the event co-organisers such as the Department of Forestry (DOF), the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH and the commissioner – the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), the Germany Embassy in Viet Nam. Particularly, statements of the German Embassy (naming Mr. Santiago Alonso Rodriguez) and of DOF leader (naming Mr. Tran Quang Bao) have been quoted in most of the reports.

A joint Press Release (PR) about the Forum in both English and Vietnamese languages were prepared by DOF and GIZ. The content was published by 23 media agencies with 09 articles being published in English (see figure below).



Beyond participants and the public, it can be noted that also media representatives have increased their awareness on the topic of gender equality in the forestry sector. With the materials shared and the input they have collected, it is expected, that further publications will follow over time. An indicator for this are requests to GIZ, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural

Development (MARD) and the German Embassy for contributions to a magazine as well as a TV programme in the environmental sector.

Take-aways: The publications included 04 narrated articles. This format especially allowed to convey the key messages and content to a more diverse audience due to the listening format.

The development of an informative press releases together with well-prepared key messages, proactive and thorough briefings to media representatives, as well as statements in the opening remarks delivered by VIPs especially attracted the media to prompt them to report about the role of gender equality in sustainable forestry development in Viet Nam.

Sharing information via networks of journalists, reporters, and media agencies strongly enhances the media echo. On the event day, GIZ sent out the press release via the GIZ Green Media Network and the newly founded VPA-FLEGT Media Network, composed of those who joined the media write-shop supported by GIZ and DoF in October 2022.



Vai trò của phụ nữ còn hạn chế

Theo Cục Lâm nghiệp, Bộ NN&PTNT, phụ nữ đã động góp đảng kể vào sư tăng trưởng nhanh chồng của nôn kinh tế làm nghiệp ở Việt Nam. Tuy nhiên, vai trò và sư đóng gặp về mặt kinh tế của phụ nữ trong các hệ thống sản xuất làm nghiệp thường bị bộ qua và đánh giá thấp.

Mốt nghiên cứu do Bộ NN&PTNT và Tổ chức GiZ phối hợp với Viên Lâm nghiệp Châu Âu thục hiện vào năm 2023, cho thấy phụ nữ trong ngành lâm nghiệp thường ít có khả năng tiếp cần đổi với các cơ hội đào tạo về chuyển môn và kỹ thuật. Do đó, thu nhập của họ thường thấp hơn nam giới; khoảng cách lượng theo giới trong ngành lâm nghiệp lớn hơn đáng kể so với các ngành kinh tế và công nghiệp khác tại Việt Nam.






